

Testnet - Bug Bounty Incentive Details

Terminology

- Version: a build of a specific commit of a release branch of <https://github.com/AntelopeIO/spring> (such as release/1.0-beta1)
- Bug: an issue reported to the Submission Form
- Reporter: An eligible entity reporting a Bug to Submission Form
- Program Termination: the end of the Bug Bounty program determined by the date of the stable release of spring 1.0 or at ENF discretion

Participation Agreement

By participating you agree that:

- You will join the [Spring Testnet Phase Telegram Group](#)
- You will cooperate with ENF and CL to determine achievement of incentives
- You may withdraw from the program at any time, keeping any incentives you've earned
- You will receive a lump sum payment inclusive of all earned incentives within 30 days of Program Termination
- Incentives will be paid in EOS or RAM
- You will submit EOS account details and KYC info to receive earned incentives
- RAM conversion prices will be determined using <https://eoseyes.com/ram/historical> based on the closing price on the date that an incentive is earned
- ENF may revoke any participant's eligibility to participate for any reason at any time
- ENF may modify this agreement at any time
- ENF may invoke Program Termination at any time

Bug Report Eligibility

- Bug must be submitted as a Github Issue prior to Program Termination
- Bug must include a descriptive title
- Bug must include clear description of the unexpected behavior
- Bug must include clear documentation of steps to replicate
- Bug body must include the RC version when Bug was first observed
- Participant must provide any other information necessary to replicate and diagnose
- Only the first report of each defect will be eligible.
- If the Bug is a Duplicate, only the first Bug reported is eligible to earn an incentive
- If ENF chooses to not fix a Bug prior to Stable, the Bug will not be considered eligible

Incentives

General Bug Report Incentive

- ENF offers an incentive to Participant for each Bug they submit

- Bug must comply with General Bug Report Incentive Eligibility to be eligible
- Incentive amount depends on elapsed time between most recent Version and Bug submission

Days since current Version	
Less than 2 days	700 EOS
Less than 3 days	350 EOS
Less than 4 days	175 EOS
5 or more days	90 EOS

Instant Finality Bug Incentive

- ENF offers incentive of 2,000 EOS to Participant for submitting critical instant finality Bug
- Bug must comply with Bug Report Eligibility to be eligible
- Bug must cause unexpected consensus behavior that is not accounted for in Instant Finality design, determined at sole discretion of ENF
- Finality Bug Report Incentive and General Bug Report Incentive are mutually exclusive
